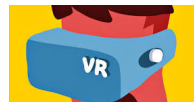

Watch items on a computer screen take shape with our new 3D printer at the People's Place and at C@P sites in the Antigonish area as listed.

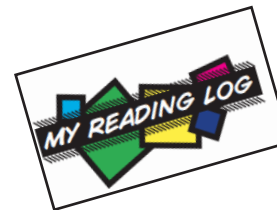

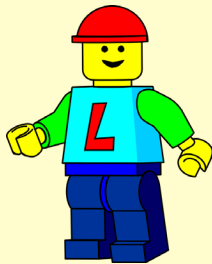
