## **eReaders, eBooks & Overdrive – a CAP workshop at the Pictou Public Library & Innovation Centre!**

On Saturday, February 12, The Pictou CAP site will be holding a workshop on the use and management of eReaders, and eBooks, through the use of Nova Scotia libraries digital catalogue.

Interested parties will learn how to download (borrow) digital books and transfer them onto the device for use anywhere, anytime. This workshop will require a library card which can be obtained at the library as well. Bring your device and any other associated cords, plugs, manuals or software. You may also bring your own laptop to work on if you wish to do so. Almost every e-reader will work with the exception of Amazon's Kindle, which is not compatible with our catalogue. The best part is you never have to return a book, they return themselves after 14 days!
