

The MacPherson Collection was donated to the Pictou-Antigonish Regional Library by Mrs. Marion MacPherson in August 1999. It consists of a number of historical as well as contemporary images pertaining to the Pictou County area. Some photographs are reproductions, others are original images.

The Collection is held in 12 binders labeled **MC** (MacPherson Collection) **A** to **L**.

- **MCA** - contains primarily military images
- **MCB** - local law enforcement, individuals, groups
- **MCC** - schools and class photos
- **MCD** - Stellarton images
- **MCE** - mines
- **MCF** - individuals, groups, buildings and various miscellaneous images
- **MCG** - mining equipment, draegermen, miners, Moose River
- **MCH** - various scenes of Westville, Pictou, Trenton
- **MCI** - images of Stellarton and rural locations throughout the county
- **MCJ** - tram cars, buses, trains, maps
- **MCK** - strip mining
- **MCL** - New Glasgow scenes, ships

Each photograph has an ID code - the letters and number found on the lower right hand corner of each image.
